As **writers**, we will continue to develop our handwriting and presentation whilst exploring the following genres:

- Persuasion

Our writing will be based on the book, Zeraffa Giraffa by Dianne Hofmeyr.

As **readers**, we will take part in year group reading sessions with a focus on fluency and comprehension. This half term we will be using the books:

Y3 – The Egyptian Cinderella by Shirley Climo

Y4 – A Myth Hunter's Travel Guide by Tom Button.

As **historians**, we will describe the achievements of the Ancient Egyptians.

As **musicians**, Y4 will be taking part in musical lessons from 'Love Music Trust' continuing to learn the clarinet and Year 3/4 will take part in music lessons with Mrs Henry focusing on music linked to Ancient Egypt.

WOW Starter:
