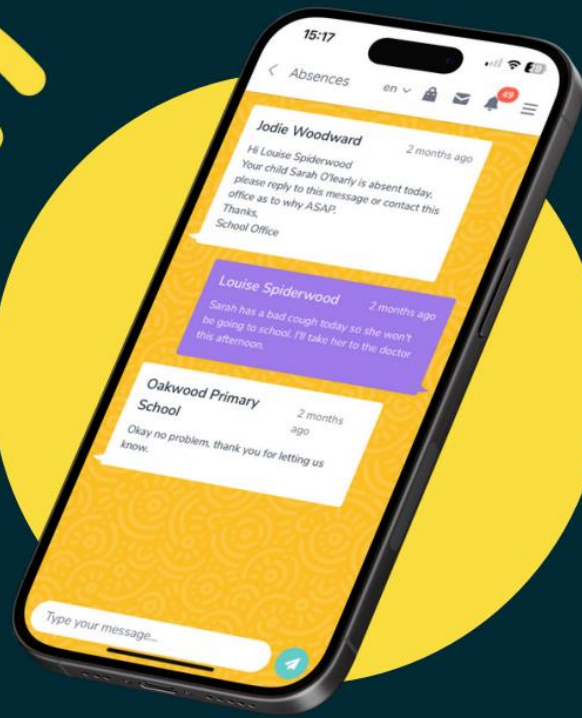

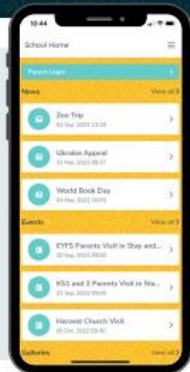


### Guide to our app for parents & carers

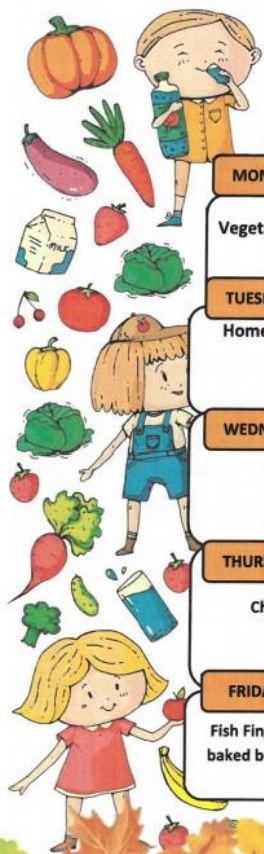
