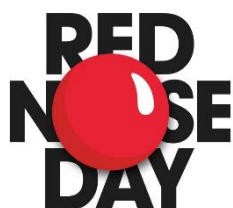
Our PTA will be running the BBQ and Jazzy Jars stalls – have you started filling your jazzy jars?
